*View the world from a different location, experience unforgettable days, gain new perspectives and enjoy magnificent views: Goals certain to meet with success thanks to the extraordinary treasures of Salzburg City and the Salzkammergut. The FestungsBahn funicular, the MönchsbergAufzug lift and the WasserSpiegel museum in the city of Mozart, as well as the SchafbergBahn cog railway and WolfgangseeSchiffahrt ferries on Wolfgangsee are all immensely popular with locals and guests alike, and have been in some cases for over 100 years. They reveal magical panoramas, lead to extraordinary dining establishments as well as world-famous sightseeing attractions: They invite you to leave every-day life behind you for a while. The ultra-modern technology, for its part, stays elegantly in the background, for nothing is more enticing than the charm of bygone days.*

Is there such a thing as love at first sight? Indeed, there is! After all, how else could you fall in love with the pretty red train carriages of the **SchafbergBahn**, as they climb through the steep, flower-strewn alpine meadows. And how could you possibly resist the gentle spray and refreshing headwind that tousle your hair aboard the **WolfgangseeSchiffahrt** ships. Both of these treasures have left their marks on this famous holiday region since the 19th century, even contributing to the diversion of the Emperor and Empress during their summer getaways in the Salzkammergut. WolfgangseeSchiffahrt ferries and the Schafberg-Bahn cog railway have both withstood the test of time and lost none of their charm. To the contrary: As the world seems to rotate ever faster, don't we appreciate a slower, easier-going pace more than ever?

The ride on the SchafbergBahn cog railway all the way up to just below the 1783 m summit takes the better part of 35 minutes and you will probably wish it could last even longer, considering the extraordinary views you are treated to by this steepest cog railway in Austria: With every vertical meter and every curve, your perspective of the world changes. At the top, passengers have 11 different lakes at their feet and, in good visibility, are also able to enjoy the sight of the mighty Hohe Tauern and Grossglockner mountains. As the biggest inland passenger shipping fleet in Austria, WolfgangseeSchiffahrt ferries invites guests to hop on or hop off spontaneously at seven different boat landings: Ports of call include Strobl, St. Wolfgang and St. Gilgen, along with a number of other beautiful spots. Elegant Jugendstil villas, turquoise waters, the midday chimes of a famous pilgrimage church and the views of the Zwölferhorn and Schafberg promise that pure, ineffable "Salzkammergut feeling"!

In Salzburg, city of Mozart, the **FestungsBahn** funicular, **WasserSpiegel** museum and **MönchsbergAufzug** lift transform the Mönchsberg, Salzburg's city mountain, into an unexpected mountain adventure. This green natural jewel in the heart of the historic district invites you to walk and stroll along the rocky trails and hidden pathways, to a number of cultural and culinary highlights. On the Mönchsberg high above the Baroque rooftops, Hohensalzburg Fortress, the Museum der Moderne, along with the multimedia Wasser-Spiegel museum exhibition: In informative and entertaining ways, this water museum inside an over 70-year-old mountain reservoir for drinking water provides intriguing insights into the history and present of Salzburg's water supply. The modern FestungsBahn funicular at the foot of Hohensalzburg Fortress is Austria's oldest funicular, while the MönchsbergAufzug lift first went into service in 1890, which makes it two years older still. Both of these treasures are the only forms of public transportation up the Mönchsberg, making them a wonderful means to leave the city behind in a matter of seconds and immerse yourself completely in the peace & quiet of nature.

Additionally, guests are offered a museum zone that delves into the history of the SchafbergBahn and WolfgangseeSchiffahrt. An old locomotive from 1893 serves as the centerpiece of the exhibit.

There is also no shortage of culinary enjoyment at the **Café & Restaurant "EQ"**, the restaurant of the new ExperienceQuarter: Here, you will also be able to enjoy the breathtaking views of Wolfgangsee and the Schafberg, and the most delightful lake terrace anywhere on Wolfgangsee.
