SEASON OPENING OF THE SCHAFBERGBAHN AND WOLFGANGSEESCHIFFFAHRT

As of March 1, the Treasures of Salzburg AG Tourismus GmbH on Lake Wolfgangsee invite you to embark on the first excursions of springtime to the Salzkammergut region.

After the SchafbergBahn cog railway and WolfgangseeSchiffahrt ferries collectively covered over 100,000 kilometers and transported nearly 1 million passengers in the course of the past year in tourism, the winter break on Lake Wolfgangsee was used to get the fleet back into tip-top shape for the new season ahead. Beginning March 1, the Wolfgangsee-Schiffahrt Ferries, the SchafbergBahn Cog Railway, and Café & Restaurant EQ will commence spring operations.

Season Opening on Lake Wolfgangsee

From March 1 to April 13, WolfgangseeSchiffahrt will operate on Saturdays and Sundays, offering spring excursions accompanied by stunning panoramic views. During the Easter holidays (April 17 – 25) and starting April 26, the ferries will be in service daily. Whether for a spring stroll or an Easter outing, the Hop On/Hop Off service around turquoise-blue Lake Wolfgangsee turns every excursion into a special experience. *Tip: The WolfgangseeTicket is an ideal companion, allowing passengers to board and disembark once at each of the seven boat landings. The ferries dock in Strobl, St. Wolfgang, St. Gilgen, and several other charming spots. Elegant Jugendstil villas, the midday chimes of the famous pilgrimage church, and the view of the surrounding mountains promise pure spring feelings!*

From March 1 through April 25, the SchafbergBahn offers rides up to the Schafbergalm station at an elevation of 1,364 meters above sea level. Until April 13, Austria's steepest cog railway operates on weekends, with daily service beginning April 17. After a 25-minute ride, the Schafbergalm station greets passengers with opportunities for leisurely hikes, and a hut serving refreshments and a bite to eat. As of April 26, Austria's steepest cog railway will once again provide rides all the way up to the 1,783-meters-high Schafberg.
